
INCORPORATE Medians And Pedestrian Refuge Islands On O Street

Medians at select locations and intersections for enhanced interest.



Pedestrian Refuge Islands (9th - Antelope Valley)

> Pedestrian Refuge space in crosswalks to create safer pedestrian crossings and slower turns.



INCORPORATE Boulevard And Pedestrian Refuge Along O Street

Boulevard Landscape (Antelope Valley - 25th)

- > Wide central median with large canopy trees.
- Increases shade, reduces heat island effect and creates more comfortable pedestrian environment.




Pedestrian Refuge Islands (Antelope Valley - 25th)

Wide central median provides opportunity for a pedestrian zone mid-crossing.



REMOVE Metered Parking On O Street

BIG IDEAS AND OPPORTUNITIES




REMOVE Metered Parking between 9th - 21st Street

- Reduce metered parking in central downtown area to enhance and expand pedestrian zone.
- Replace existing metered parking with Pick-Up and Drop-Off ONLY Zones.
- Encourage visitors and guests to park their vehicles in the available parking garages.



DEFINE Parking On O Street

DEFINE Parking on O Street between 21st - 27th Street

- Incorporate curb bulb-outs to define parallel parking spaces along East O Street.
- Introduce street trees and understory planting with the space gained by introducing bulb-outs.
- > Eliminate underutilized parking spaces and replace with planting and pedestrian public realm space.









REMOVE Parking On Centennial Mall And Connect Open Space


REMOVE Parking on Centennial Mall:

- Remove parking on the East side of Centennial Mall (between M and O) and increase the open green space.
- Provide a public realm open space connection through O Street



GATEWAY Plaza At O Street (Between 9th And 10th)


GATEWAY Plaza

- Iconic architectural element at the primary entry to downtown O street (from west)
- Opportunity for activated public open space at crossroads between O and Haymarket District
- Remove large landscape and overgrown hedges to open up visual corridors




4-way Red Light For Vehicles So Pedestrians Cross All Directions At The Same Time

4-way RED LIGHT for pedestrians:

- > Historically, the star at 13th street was a 4-way red light to allow diagonal crossing.
- Opportunity to study current vehicular patterns and trends to identify an appropriate 4-way stop intersection.
- > Traffic calming to reduce high speed vehicular traffic.






REVITALIZE bridge to align to O Street Aesthetic:

14th Street ENHANCEMENTS

Festival Street concept to facilitate street events and entertainment and pedestrian connectivity`

A Festival Street is a portion of public right-of-way identified for recurring temporary closure to vehicle traffic use for the purpose of pedestrian-oriented special activities. Activities may include music or dance performances, art installations, festivals, or other community events and celebrations.




- > Curb-less pedestrian oriented street


11th Street Enhancement and Lane Removal

- Remove lane and increase public realm space for greenway connection from O Street.
- Opportunity to create an expansive North/South Greenway Street through downtown (Q Street to Lincoln Mall).
- Wide enough Open Space Corridor for programmed spaces and amenities.



CREATE Low Stakes Incubator Space

Low Stakes Incubator Spaces

- Incorporation of street vendors, boutique popups, food trucks, kiosks, etc.
- Design spaces that can be scaled up to allow local businesses to occupy during permitted hours.
- Activity on the along the street will add interest between ecosystems.
